Applications are currently being accepted for a Part Time Multi-Site Registered Dietitian position for the Walkerton and Kincardine sites of the South Bruce Grey Health Centre.

Reporting to the Manager of Environmental Services, the Registered Dietitian works within his/her scope of professional practice in an interdisciplinary team environment to coordinate all phases of nutrition care. This includes nutrition assessment, care planning, monitoring, education and counselling of hospitalized patients in a variety of settings. The Registered Dietitian performs duties in support of and in compliance with professional standards and evidence based practice guidelines. The Registered Dietitian acts as a consultant and resource for other health care professionals with regards to nutritional care and management.

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Bachelor's Degree in Human Nutrition or equivalent
- Graduate from an accredited Internship/Masters Practicum Program
- Membership with the College of Dietitians of Canada (in good standing)
- Minimum 2 years' recent clinical experience
- Certified Diabetes Educator preferred
- Experience in providing instruction to clients and health professionals

- Demonstrated ability to function effectively in a team environment and as an independent practitioner
