- Recent Cardiac ultrasound experience in a hospital environment considered an asset
- Adult cardiac ultrasound experience as a registered cardiac sonographer: pediatric or fetal echocardiography considered an asset
- Able to maintain confidentiality
- Advanced Computer skills
- Ability to multi-task and prioritize a variety of functions
- Proven interpersonal skills to successfully communicate with patients and staff
